Directions

From Mechanicsburg & Camp Hill: Follow Trindle Road (Rt 641 West, which is Main Street in Mechanicsburg) to 1/4 mile past the Rt 174 intersection, turn right onto Artcraft Drive to The Art Center barn.

From Carlisle: Follow Rt 641 East to 1/2 mile past Locust Point Road. Turn left onto Artcraft Drive to The Art Center barn.

From Route 83: Take Rt 83 to Rt 581 West toward Camp Hill. See directions below.

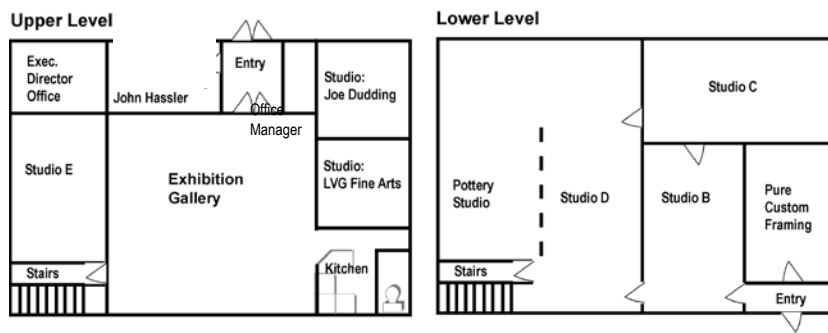
From Rt 581 West: Take Mechanicsburg/Rt 641 Exit, turning right at the end of the ramp and right again at Trindle Road (Rt 641 W). Continue west, through Mechanicsburg, to 1/4 mile past the Rt 174 intersection. Turn right onto Artcraft Drive to the Art Center barn.

From Route 81: Take Exit 57 (Mechanicsburg/Rt 114). Turn onto Rt 114 East at end of ramp. Continue straight through intersection at Carlisle Pike (Rt 11) to the intersection of Rt 641 in Mechanicsburg. Turn right onto Rt 641 West and continue to 1/4 mile past the Rt 174 intersection. Turn right onto Artcraft Drive to the Art Center barn.

From PA Turnpike: Take Rt 15/Mechanicsburg/ Gettysburg exit. Take Rt 15 South. See directions below.

From Route 15: Take route 15 to the Bowmansdale/Rt 114 Exit. Turn West onto Rt 114 toward Mechanicsburg. Continue to Mechanicsburg town square and turn left onto Rt 641 West. Continue West to 1/4 mile past the Rt 174 intersection. Turn right onto Artcraft Drive to the Art Center barn.
